CALL FOR ENTRIES

2017 AIANH Design Awards – Unbuilt Architecture

ELIGIBILITY

Unbuilt architectural designs of any project type are eligible including purely theoretical projects and unbuilt client-sponsored projects (buildings, interiors, transportation infrastructure, monuments, etc. – all project types). Projects under construction or otherwise apparently assured of construction are not eligible. Architects who submit must be members of AIA New Hampshire. Emerging professionals do not need to be members but must be working in a New Hampshire firm. Students do not need to be members, but must be either from New Hampshire or attending school in New Hampshire.

There are no restrictions on the presumed or imagined location of projects. The intent is to invite unbuilt work by practicing design professionals, design educators, and design students from New Hampshire.

Submitters may work in teams of up to three people.

CRITERIA

The jurors' decisions will be based on the materials submitted. The jury may create award tiers and categories as it deems appropriate.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Submission Registration: Entrants should register their submission/s [online](#).

Once you have registered you will receive instructions on how to upload your submissions.

Entry due date: Entries are due by 5 p.m. October 14, 2016.

Fees:

AIANH Architect members: \$75.00 for the first entry; additional entries \$40 each.

Emerging Professionals and Students: \$25 for the first board, \$10 for additional boards.

Payment may be made by credit card or check. Checks should be sent separately from the entries themselves. Entry fees are non-refundable.



Submission fulfillment: Entries must be complete, adhere to the submission requirements below, include all supporting documents, and the entry fees must be paid. Projects that do not fulfill these requirements cannot be accepted.

SUBMISSION FORMAT AND REQUIREMENTS

All submissions for the 2017 AIANH Design Awards Unbuilt Projects must be digital. Entries must be complete, adhere to the submission format below, include all supporting documents, and the entry fees must be paid. Projects that do not fulfill these requirements cannot be accepted. The jurors' decisions will be based solely on the materials submitted.

PDF Submission:

All materials listed below shall be formatted on eight (8) or fewer pages, not larger than 8 1/2" x 11" each, and submitted as a PDF document. The file size shall not exceed 12MB. All reference to the submitter's name or architecture firm must be concealed on all materials submitted for review.

Each file shall include, as appropriate and available, the following information in this order:

1. Using 10 pt type or larger and not exceeding one page, include the following project information:
 - Project Name
 - Narrative that includes at least one simple sentence explaining what the project is and what the context is (neighborhood, urban, rural, climate, etc.).
2. Drawings or other images that best represent the project. These may include site plan, floor plans, elevations, sections, and renderings. You may include up to two graphic images per page.

Supporting Documents:

1. An informational sheet with the following information:
 - Designer's name/s (add suffixes such as AIA or Assoc. AIA as appropriate)
 - Firm or Institution, if applicable
 - Contact person
 - Mailing address
 - City/State/Postal Code
 - Email
 - Cell phone
2. Two-four jpg images (6 x 8 inches, 300 dpi) of some part of the project to use for publicity. These should be 300 dpi jpegs at approximately 4 x 6 inches (1800 pixels wide). The images will be used in a PowerPoint presentation at the Awards Banquet, for publication, and for the AIANH website People's Choice Awards program. Please identify the lead photo you want for publicity. Title the photos with your name and project name, and number one through two (Name_Project_01).
3. A photo release form (see last page of this document). Please fill out, scan, and upload as a pdf.

4. A single 20" x 20" x 3/16" (or 1/4") foam-core board is also required for each project. This is for exhibition only and should include the submitter's name and firm. Boards are to be two-dimensional (using drawings, plans, photos, narrative material, etc.) and must not be framed or otherwise encumbered with metal, wood, glass, plastic or similar materials. While images of models may be included on your board, actual models are not eligible. Be sure the text on the board includes at least one simple sentence explaining what the project is and what the context is (neighborhood, urban, rural, climate, etc.). This board is not for the jurors, but for our annual Awards submissions tour around the state and the annual exhibit and will not be returned unless you make specific arrangements for pick up after the exhibits have concluded. You may ship the board to the AIANH office by November 1, or you may send a PDF of the board to us plus payment of \$60/per board, and we will get it printed for you. Payment for the boards may be made online when you register or you may send us a check.

How to prepare your board files for uploading:

- ✓ Name electronic file with your firm name and abbreviated project name (example: ABC Design_FrostHospital_board.)
- ✓ Document size should be 20 x 20 inches 200-300 dpi.
- ✓ When creating your board, If importing a photo to a layout program such as InDesign, make sure the imported photo is at least 200 dpi and no more than 300 dpi at the dimensions used on the board. Do not import and increase or decrease size of photo in the layout program.
- ✓ Color Mode: RGB. Digital photos should be in sRGB colorspace for the best color/quality match.
- ✓ File type: provide a PDF saved at high resolution or a high quality uncompressed JPEG.

AWARDS SUBMISSIONS EXHIBIT

All submissions will be on view at the annual AIANH Awards Banquet and at various sites throughout the State during 2017, including the Manchester-Boston Airport.

AWARDS GALA

The Awards Gala will be held in January 20, 2017 (snow date: January 22) at the Manchester Country Club, Bedford, NH.
