

## New Hampshire Architecture Foundation



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The New Hampshire Architecture Foundation was established by the New Hampshire Chapter of The American Institute of Architects in 2007 as a grant-making vehicle for programs supporting its mission: *to foster understanding of quality in architectural design, construction, and preservation by raising public awareness of and expectations for architecture and the built environment and to encourage individuals to act as advocates for good design in the planning and design processes that shape their communities.*

Providing scholarship assistance to future design professionals is an important part of the work that supports our mission.

The Foundation and the New Hampshire Chapter of the American Institute of Architects jointly sponsor two scholarships.

### **Eligibility**

In order to be considered for an AIA/NH Architecture Foundation Scholarship a candidate must be New Hampshire resident or a child of full-time New Hampshire residents.

### **AIA/NH Architecture Foundation Scholarship**

Awarded to students who are currently enrolled in or have been accepted to an undergraduate or graduate professional degree program accredited by the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB). 1-2 scholarships of \$500-\$3,000 may be awarded.

### **AIA/NH Architecture Foundation Related Field Scholarship**

Awarded to students who are currently enrolled in or who have been accepted to an accredited undergraduate program with an architecture major, or in an undergraduate or graduate program in a related field such as Landscape Architecture, Architectural History, Architectural Preservation, Planning. 1-2 scholarships of \$500-\$3,000 may be awarded.

### **Application Process:**

*To apply for one of these scholarships, send all of the following as a pdf file.*

1. Application
2. A one-page letter describing your accomplishments and goals
3. Two letters of reference from teachers, employers, or community members.
4. Submit your design for one favorite project and explain your rationale for the design.
5. Official transcript from current school or school you have just graduated from.

Preferred method of submission is to fill out the completed application and scan related documents and return by email in one PDF file to [office@aianh.org](mailto:office@aianh.org). Transcript may be sent under separate cover.
