ANNUAL DESIGN AWARDS PROGRAM

K-12 EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

AIA New Hampshire is committed to building the pipeline of design talent that will continue to staff current and future firms in the state. Three important programs are the current focus of the chapter's attention:

— THINK3D!

Think3D! teaches third through sixth grade students spatial reasoning skills critical to their success and perseverance in science, technology, engineering and math, all of which are foundational to the profession of architecture. Playful and engaging, the program inspires innovative thinking and problem solving through a sequence of engineering design challenges based in origami and paper engineering.

ANNUAL HIGH SCHOOL DESIGN COMPETITION

Sometimes their first introduction to architecture, this competition is enjoyed by students across New Hampshire who compete in challenges that ask them to consider their communities and how the built environment can be a catalyst for sustainability and human interaction.

— COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

Since 2009 AIA New Hampshire has offered over \$55,000 in scholarships to college students of architecture. Supporting those who have chosen architecture for their career is important to the mission of chapter.

EMERGING PROFESSIONALS

Through its Emerging Professionals Network, AIA New Hampshire nurtures early career architects to reach their potential. Specially tailored programs are offered to Emerging Professionals each year: building construction tours, study aids to prepare for the professional licensing exams and social events for peer networking are just some of the initiatives.
