Here are some other opportunities for more engagement with the AIA New Hampshire community.

PRESIDENTS' DINNER

AIA New Hampshire's President's Dinner will have its inaugural event in 2024. Bringing together past chapter presidents is an opportunity to recognize firm leadership across the state, as AIANH presidents are typically senior members of their firms. The Presidents' Dinner keeps this influential group connected to each other and to the chapter, allowing them to collectively assess the state of the profession and collaborate on initiatives that will positively impact the built environment. There will be a single sponsorship opportunity to underwrite this dinner for one chapter partner to be in the room where it happens.

ANNUAL DESIGN AWARDS PROGRAM

The Design Awards Gala, a marquis event in the chapter, is held each year to draw attention to buildings in New Hampshire that demonstrate design excellence. The gala draws the largest attendance of design practitioners and building industry experts from across New Hampshire and beyond for a festive occasion.

K-12 EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

AIA New Hampshire is committed to building the pipeline of design talent that will continue to staff current and future firms in the state. Two important programs are the current focus of the chapter's attention:

- THINK3D!

Think3d! teaches third through sixth grade students spatial reasoning skills critical to their success and perseverance in science, technology, engineering and math, all of which are foundational to the profession of architecture. Playful and engaging, the program inspires innovative thinking and problem solving through a sequence of engineering design challenges based in origami and paper engineering.

- COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

Since 2009 AIA New Hampshire has offered over \$50,000 in scholarships to college students of architecture. Supporting those who have chosen architecture for their career is important to the mission of chapter.

EMERGING PROFESSIONALS

Through its Emerging Professionals Network, AIA New Hampshire nurtures early career architects to reach their potential. Specially tailored programs are offered to Emerging Professionals each year: building construction tours, study aids to prepare for the professional licensing exams and social events for peer networking are just some of the initiatives.

CHAPTER MEETINGS AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS
